The Greenland Business Association has been representing the interests of the business community in Greenland since 1966. The organisation currently has about 350 member companies with a total of around 6,000 employees in all of the country's business sectors – from small and medium-sized companies to large firms operating in the international markets.

The Greenland Business Association is Greenland's dominant employer and business organisation. The organisation represents the vast majority of companies, and approximately 80% of the country's business turnover. This secures a central position for the Greenland Business Association on the labour market, as well as in relation to the country's political leadership and public authorities.

The Greenland Business Association has all of Greenland as its workplace, with the clear goal of creating the best possible framework for the business community. This means that membership of the Greenland Business Association is the key to influencing business development, and provides direct access to a community of colleagues, which gives strength.
