



## NunaGreen A/S Company profile

NunaGreen A/S was established in 2022 with the mission to advance and further develop Greenland's renewable energy potentials.

Our purpose includes managing financial interests, building expertise, and driving the development and export of green energy within and beyond Greenland.

Additionally, NunaGreen is tasked with financing, constructing, owning, and operating hydropower plants, ensuring Greenland's participation in sustainable energy initiatives.

## Hydropower

As a government-owned company, NunaGreen is spearheading two pivotal hydropower projects: the expansion of the Utoqqarmiut Kangerluarsunnguat hydropower plant near Nuuk and the construction of a new plant in Disko Bay. These projects are a cornerstone of our commitment to supplying Greenland with domestic green energy, focusing on financial management, securing government permits, overseeing construction, and driving business.

In close collaboration with the national utility company Nukissiorfiit, NunaGreen will nearly double Greenland's green energy capacity.



In 2025, NunaGreen plans to tender for the expansion of Utoqqarmiut Kangerluarsunnguat hydropower plant, which includes the construction of a new 76.9 MW power station near Kangerluarsunnguup Tasia, connected by a 16 km tunnel and a 37 km trans-mission line to the existing facility.



Simultaneously, the Disko Bay hydro-power project will generate 22 MW through three turbines, utilizing a 6 km transfer tunnel to link two mountain lakes. Transmission lines will connect to substations in Qasigiannguit and Aasiaat, further bolstering the region's energy infrastructure.



## Vision

NunaGreen's vision is to power Greenland and beyond with green energy.

By developing state-of-the-art projects, we are dedicated to transition Greenland into a sustainable energy future, creating long-term value for the country's economy and environment.
